KDJFC Player Play Up Policy

Purpose

This policy is designed to provide guidance to all members, players, parents, committee, and team officials in clarifying the club's stance on player play ups during the season. This policy is addition to the WAFC 2024 Junior Football Competition Policies, Rules and Regulations handbook.

KDJFC Play Up Policy Clarifications

1. Players can play up a maximum of 4 games throughout the season.
2. KDJFC will not allow Year 6 players Male or Female to play up in the Youth Year 7 or Year 7/8 competition.
3. No players are allowed to play up during the first 5 rounds of the season.
4. If your team cannot field the minimum numbers required for a game and may forfeit, please contact the Registrar as soon as possible.
5. Play Ups are to be used to avoid a forfeiture, not to create a full bench.
6. Please see the table below for year groups and who can/can't play up.

Year	Who can play up
7/8 Team	Year 8's can play in the 9/10 team. Year 7's are not permitted to play up.
9/10 Team	Year 10's can play in the 11/12 team. Year 9's are not permitted to play up.
7 Mixed	Can play in year 8 team
8 Mixed	Can play in the year 9 team
9 Mixed	Can play in the year 10 team
10 Male	Can play in the Y11/12 male team

Play Up Procedures

Play up requests are to be emailed to registrar@kdjfc.com.au as soon as possible, as the player will need to be temporarily added to the team and approval obtained from WAFC.

Written confirmation is to be provided to the Registrar from a parent/guardian of the player playing up confirming they are aware of the play up request and happy for their child to play.
